LTS Group adds 70 MAN trucks to its fleet

THE Lee Ting San Group of Companies (LTS Group) has added 70 MAN prime movers to its fleet for long haul transport.

The MAN TGS 19.360 4x2 will make up one-third of the logistics specialist's existing fleet of prime movers.

Based in Prai, the company commands a fleet of close to 1,000 vehicles that supports its nationwide and cross-border transportation services.

The company has a haulage hub and distribution centres in various locations across Malaysia including Penang, Prai, Port Klang, KLIA and Bukit Kayu Hitam while its distribution net-

work even extends to Singapore and Thailand.

The 4x2 hauler which weighs around 360kg less than a standard semitrailer tractor gives it an advantage when it comes to payload while being lightweight, therefore making it fuel efficient.

MAN Truck and Bus (M) Sdn Bhd managing director Hartmut Mueller said, "A key objective of MAN is to supply fuel efficient trucks that significantly lower the total cost of ownership and it is encouraging to know that the LTS Group has found the MAN TGS more than capable of meeting its stringent requirement in this area."
